Let's do the Good Works Ephesians 2:10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. <u>Unbroken – the story of Louis Zamperini</u>

On a May afternoon in 1943, a US bomber crashed into the Pacific Ocean. After an agonising delay, a young lieutenant finally bobbed to the surface and struggled aboard a life raft. So begins one of the most extraordinary odysseys of the Second World War. The lieutenant's name was Louis Zamperini. As a boy, he turned to petty crime until he discovered a remarkable talent for running, which took him to the Berlin Olympics. But as war loomed, he joined up and was soon embroiled in the ferocious battle for the Pacific. Now Zamperini faced a journey of thousands of miles of open ocean on a failing raft, dogged by sharks, starvation and the enemy. Driven to limits of endurance, Zamperini's fate, whether triumph or tragedy, would depend on the strength of his will...

I read this book and found that I could not put it down. A comment Louis made has stayed with me. Louis said that had he known what was before him he would never have survived. I think of God's goodness in only releasing his plan for us on a day to day basis so that we are not swamped or without hope.

We need the Andrews



'My coffee & conversations with James:' ... from Ron Oastler.

The wind was a bit too chill down at the marina the other day – a cool Easterly was blowing across the harbour waters - so James came around to our place for our coffee & conversation...

Typical of James, just as he sat down in a comfortable chair he started our conversation with a question: 'Well,' he said, 'what do you know or remember about Andrew, 'the quiet one', from the New Testament record?'

Not a bad opening gambit for an interesting conversation, I thought.

I remembered the account in John 1 where Andrew had his first encounter with Jesus, so I offered: 'He was Simon Peter's brother...he was a disciple of John the Baptist...and... when John pointed Jesus out as being the 'Lamb of God' Andrew turned and followed Jesus to where He was staying,...and of course...he went and told Simon Peter: 'we have found the Messiah' and brought him to Jesus.'

'Anything else about Andrew?' James prodded.

'Let me think ...Oh yes...there was another time...when Jesus asked how they might feed the people who had been gathered to hear Him, Andrew was the one, according to John 6:9, who said: 'Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish', was my response.

'Good. Now, interesting is it not, that in that first account Andrew showed that he was spiritually oriented as well as relationship

oriented. He not only supported the spiritual message of John the Baptist but connected with him personally as a disciple. Yes? Then when John pointed to the Messiah, his spirit responded and he took action to relate directly with Jesus. Finally, when he was convinced about whom Jesus was, his automatic reaction was relationship focused and he brought his brother to meet Jesus. Andrew was a real people person with a real sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.'

Then without drawing a breath James continued: '...and what do we see in the account of the loaves and fish? Who found the lad with the lunch-bag? Andrew. How? Chance? I think not. Being a people person he would have been the one who made friends in the crowd between times. Chatting with folk he probably asked 'what have you got there my lad?'...and heard that the lad's mother had packed peasant bread and some fish. So what does Andrew do then? He brought the lad to meet Jesus, not necessarily knowing quite what to expect, but expecting something, I believe.'

'OK James, where are you taking me in this revelation?' I asked.

'Well, there is one more cameo of Andrew at which we should look before I answer that question. This is the account in John 12 where some Greeks who were attending Passover, asked Philip to introduce them to Jesus. What did Philip do? He went and told Andrew...Yes? And Andrew accompanied him to Jesus. Why? Because Andrew was the people person who was used to bringing people to Jesus AND he knew that 'any two agreeing on what they ask, it will be done.'' So Andrew brought them to Jesus.


In a rather emphatic tone, James then stated his case: 'To put it unequivocally, we need to foster more Andrews within the Fellowship. We do not need more prominent men – we need more significant men. We need men who are spiritually oriented. Men who are also relationship oriented - who relate readily with others. We need the Andrews of today who are both Holy Spirited and people oriented.

We need to encourage a generation of 'Andrews', who will bring others to Jesus.'



ASA CANDLER – COCA COLA

Asa Candler was the entrepreneur behind Coca Cola and a fantastic example of what a Christian can do when he puts God first in his business. Starting from humble beginnings as a drugstore owner in Atlanta, he purchased the Coca Cola



secret formula in 1888 and through his innovative marketing, sales and distribution efforts, grew Coca Cola into a national brand and an extraordinarily profitable business. As Candler was a major philanthropist for the Methodist Church and his contributions are still felt today, some 85 years since he went to be with the Lord. His \$1M gift to a small college in Oxford, GA to become the Methodist College of the South, became the prestigious Emory University we know today. He also gave millions to what is now Emory Hospital. Candler was elected mayor of Atlanta in 1916. Another giant for God.

Former Mafia Captain Works for a New Boss by Kevin Miller

CONTINUED..... A 19 year old dancer managed to do what a Federal task force could not. Michael was so taken in by Cammy and her genuine commitment to the God in whom she believed, that he planned to do what no other "made member" of La Cosa Nostra had done before him. Quit! Others before him had defected to become informants, slipping into the cover of the witness protection program. But no one had ever quit. The timing was right. The feds had managed to turn one of Michael's principal business associates and hit him with yet another racketeering indictment. Seeing it as an opportunity to begin his break from the mob, Franzese instructed his attorneys to negotiate a plea with the government attorneys. Rather then proceed to trial, he would plead guilty, do some time and gradually plan his defection from the mob life. He would marry Cammy, move to the west coast and settle there upon his release from prison, far from the mobbed up streets of Brooklyn. The government jumped at the opportunity to convict him. He would agree to a 10 year sentence, \$15 million restitution and forfeiture of considerable assets. The deal was done. Michael's plan was in motion. Apparently, however, God had another plan. Cammy had introduced Michael to her faith in Christ, an introduction that ultimately led to his surrender, not just to the law, but to grace, to the Lordship of Jesus. Vanity Fair called Cammy "the woman who changed the face of organized crime in America" because of her impact on Michael, an impact she continues today as his wife of 22+ years. After serving five

parole to begin his life new life with Cammy. But the government was relentless in their desire to have Michael cooperate against his former associates. And the family boss wanted him dead. Under tremendous pressure from both sides, he violated his parole and was sent back to prison for what the feds assured him would be a very long stretch. "This was the darkest moment in my life. Everyone was mad at me – the mob, the Feds, even my wife. What would Cammy do now? What about my kids? Would I survive the mob's fury in prison? I was angry with myself, beaten down -- emotionally drained. The pain I felt in my heart was unbearable. A guard walked by my cell and noticed my demeanour, asking if I was OK. He left and returned with a bible. I never saw him again. Angry with God, I threw the Bible against the wall. Although I had turned on God for that moment, God did not turn on me. The Bible fell open to Proverbs 16:7 - 'When a man's ways are pleasing to the Lord, he makes even his enemies be at peace with him.' The fellowship of a prison guard completed what Cammy had started. That night, alone and on my knees, I surrendered control of my life to the God in whom I had only believed." The fed's plan for a very long prison stretch turned into Michael's serving 3 years in the hole where he hungered to develop his personal relationship with Jesus. God's plan for Michael's life was in full motion. Upon his release, Michael was recruited to educate student and professional athletes about the dangers of gambling. He is a regular speaker at Christian events, including Churches, Men's Groups and Festivals, and he is frequently the keynote at events for corporations, business and law schools, and law enforcement groups. years in prison Michael was released on
